After months of Investigation and through inquiry the fact finding committee reported the following -



I knew I had an understanding of both sides and the communication and technical skill sets to help. So last year, I presented to our board of LPS a plan for a revolutionary website to meet our needs. The board graciously allowed me to proceed and put much faith in me to accomplish this goal. I asked for and received a budget and now I have accomplished the goal using resources from India.




